Reminder: Fluorescein Only Available Directly from Manufacturer

ASRS has been in conversations with Alcon regarding the ongoing supply issues related to Fluorescein. Due to Akorn ceasing operations, Alcon's Fluorescite is the only available product on the market. While quantities are limited to 36 vials a day, retina specialists and practices may order directly from Alcon by contacting customer service at 1-800-862-5266.

Previously, Alcon shared a [letter](#) to the retina community with ASRS regarding the supply issues.



International Webinar Recording Explores Retinal Detachment Surgery Across the Western Hemisphere

On May 2, the American Society of Retina Specialists, the Mexican Retina Association, the Canadian Retina Society, and the Pan-American Retina & Vitreous Society co-hosted ***Fixing Challenging Retinal Detachments From Across the Western Hemisphere.***

A recording is now available of the webinar that explores multiple cases of retinal detachment management from an international perspective. Highlights include discussion about pneumatic retinopexy, tips for fixing diabetic traction detachments, help for eyes in people with Stickler's syndrome, and retinal detachment repair in eyes with concurrent macular holes.

The webinar is moderated by ASRS International Committee Chair, Sunir Garg, MD, FACRS, FASRS, who is joined by a distinguished panel of renowned retinal surgeons including Audina Berrocal, MD, FASRS, Gerardo Garcia-Aguirre, MD, Lihteh Wu, MD, and Rajeev H. Muni, MD, MSC, FRCS(C), FASRS.

Open for Late-
Breaking Papers
and WinR Cases!**

The [abstract system is now open](#) for late-breaking papers and WinR Case Conference submissions to be considered for the 2023 Annual Meeting, July 28-August 1 in Seattle.

ASRS members are invited to [submit one late-breaking abstract](#).

If you have already accepted an invitation to present a paper and your late-breaking abstract is accepted, the original abstract will be placed as a paper-on-demand instead. Please note that members are allowed only one podium presentation. A non-member may not submit an abstract in this category. The deadline for late breaking abstracts is **June 16**.

Requirements for late-breaking abstracts are as follows:

- Priority will be given to first-time results of clinical trials that have not been presented to date.
- Abstracts must be true late breakers (i.e. data was not available at time of original abstract deadline in February).
- Late-breaking abstracts will be interspersed into the scientific symposia Saturday, July 29 through Tuesday, August 1. Members should ensure their availability over these dates before submitting.



WinR Case Conference Submissions

ASRS members are also invited to [submit an abstract](#) of an interesting, challenging, or unusual medical or surgical case for the WinR Case Conference, which will be held on Sunday evening July 30 during the ASRS Annual Meeting. Abstracts must be submitted by **June 16**.


- A letter of recommendation from an active ASRS member from the candidate's current institution
